ADA Wins Top Award At School Conference

ROSEMONT, Ill. — American Dairy Association (ADA) received the award for the most outstanding single booth at the July 24-26 American School Food Service Association (ASFS) conference in Orlando, Fla.

In its first appearance as an ASFS conference, ADA introduced the 1989 school foodservice program, "Dairy is Delicious, Pass it on!" The ADA booth attracted attention through an interactive spin-the-wheel game and offered details about the new foodservice program which is designed to promote school lunches featuring dairy and other commodity foods while meeting the national guidelines for school lunch programs.

ASFS conference attendees were invited to join the in-booth game and spin the "Win, Choose or Draw" wheel. If the wheel landed on "win," the player was automatically entered in a drawing for

an ice cream machine and received a "Dairy is Delicious" button. If the wheel indicated "Choose," the player received a button and could either enter the drawing or spin again. If the spin landed on "Draw," the player had his/her caricature drawn and received a button.

ADA was one of five ASFS award recipients recognized for an exhibit which encouraged interaction with conference attendees and appropriately promoted its theme. The ASFS conference featured 1,600 booths and attendance topped 7,000.

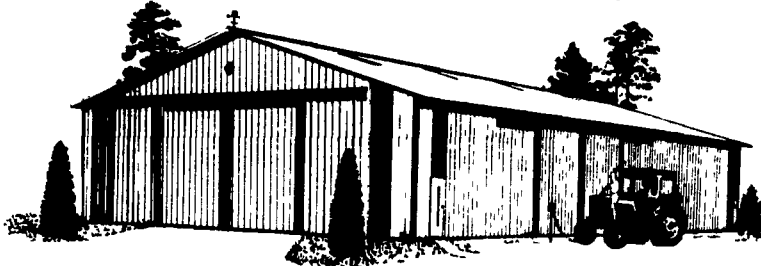
