 each other in last year's fair splitting the championship honors.  
 Young Matt Trostle of Red Lion and Luke Zerby of Beavertown vied for the champion titles in the Southdown division. Zerby showed the champion ram while 10-year-old Trostle had the reserve. In the ewe championship match, the results were flopped with Trostle's yearling taking the purple rosette.  
 The top Suffolk honors stayed in York County with Julie Kern and Paul Leader eaching having a champion and reserve. Kern's

yearling ram, Frosty, is her first champion breeding sheep in the three years she's been a 4-H'er. But he is not the 11-year-old's first champion: last year she had the grand champion lamb at the county roundup. Kern also showed the fair's reserve champion ram.

Leader, from York, showed both champion ewes, continuing his long-time winning streak.

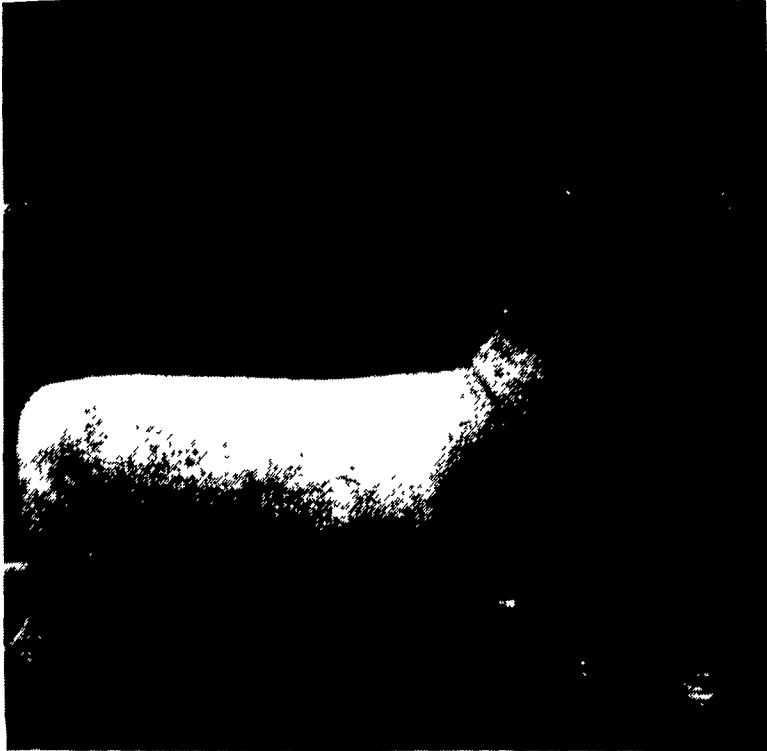
