USDA DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN MARKET SUMMARY

CASH GRAIN PRICES SHARPLY LOWER WEDNESDAY. CROP PRODUCTION REPORT RELEASED LATE TUESDAY, CONSTRUED AS BEARISH AND PRICES TUMBLED ON THE BOARD OF TRADE. RAINS REPLENISHING SOIL MOISTURE MANY PLACES TO IMPROVE PROSPECTS FOR 1990 CROPS. TALKS THAT U.S.D.A. MAY ALLOW 110 PERCENT WHEAT ALLOTMENT FOR NEXT YEAR. ALSO, EXPORT ORDERS COMING UP SHORT THIS WEEK. THESE FACTORS OVER-SHADOWED OTHER CROP YIELD PREDICTIONS. TOO MUCH RAIN IN PLACES AND THE DETRIMENT OF 89 CORN AND SOY-

BEAN CROP AND RECORD LOW TEMPERATURES IN MIDWEST, NORTHERN PLAINS AND OUT WEST BRINGING REPORTS OF FROST AND SNOW.
