1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$4.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50-4. 00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-

ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED \$1.00 HIGHER TO \$1.00 LOWER IN A LIGHT TEST. IN THE MIDWEST THEY WERE \$1.00-1.50 LOWER.

COWS AND BULL PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE STEADY TO \$6.00 HIGH-ER AS MIDWES PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 15% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 10% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 6 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

**VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-**NIA WERE NOT TESTED AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY. VEAL AND CALF PRODUC-TION WAS 10% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 10% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 9 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE \$1.00 TO \$3.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 5% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 7% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.


