Hydraulic-drive models offer varied basket speed to ground speed for uniform control of windrows. When wet windrows are a problem, the hydraulic-drive system can be reversed for gentle tedding or fluffing and fast drying.

All three models are designed with formed steel channels that distribute weight across the main frame for positive traction and stability during turns. They also feature a staggered wheel position that distributes the basket-weight for improved flotation and stability during turns.

Basket height is adjustable with a single crank and all models are also equipped with a handy tilt adjustment to quickly position the basket for a variety of crop conditions. In addition, five raking bars

with "tooth bar scrapers" prevent trash from accumulating.

Other options include a choice of clevis hitch and jack or caster wheel. For difficult or short crops, extra teeth can be added to convert from two teeth per position to three per position.

The dual raking system joins the Models 960 and 970, allowing the operator to combine two swaths or windrows into one windrow to save time during haying. It also provides consistent windrows ideal for high-capacity rectangular or round baling.




