Rules For Junior

All-Pennsylvania Awards

The Junior All-Pennsylvania Awards will be made in 1989 under the following rules:

Classes Recognized - Junior Heifer Calf - Born March 1, 1989 - April 30, 1989; Intermediate Heifer Calf - Born December 1, 1988 - February 29, 1989; Senior Heifer Calf - Born September 1, 1988 - November 30, 1988; Summer Yearling Heifer - Born June 1, 1988 - August 31, 1988; Junior Yearling Heifer - Born March 1, 1988 - May 31, 1988; Intermediate Yearling Heifer - born December 1, 1987 - February 28, 1988; Senior Yearling Heifer - Born September 1, 1987 - November

30, 1987; Junior 2-Year-Old - Born March 1, 1987 - August 31, 1987; Senior 2-Year-Old - Born September 1, 1986 - February 28, 1987; Three-Year-Old - Born September 1, 1985 - August 31, 1986; Four-Year-Old - Born September 1, 1984 - August 31, 1985; Five-Year-Old - Born September 1, 1983 - August 31, 1984; 100,000 lb. Cow - Cow any age that has shown in the 100,000 lb. class. An animal can be entered in either individual age class or the 100,000 lb. class. NOT BOTH. Aged Cow - Born prior to September 1, 1983.

Ownership - Each animal competing must be registered in the Herd Book of the Holstein-Friesian Association of America in the name of its Junior exhibitor and meet the requirements of Junior project work and for exhibition at 4-H, FFA or Junior State Shows or fairs. The exhibitor must be the sole owner of the animal at all shows in which she is exhibited.

Title by January 1, 1989 (for 2 year olds and over) May 1, 1989 (for calves and yearlings). Title of all animals over 2 years old in this competition must be shown on the registry certificate with ownership recorded by January 1, 1989 as shown by the filing date on the transfer. The date of ownership on animals showing as yearlings and

calves must be recorded by May 1, 1989. All ownership records will be checked by the Holstein Association of America and their decision on eligibility under this rule will be final.

Partnership Animals - Upon recommendation of the Extension Committee and management of Holstein Association of America and in line with the rules for 4-H exhibition in the great majority of shows, all entries must stand on the Association records in the individual name of the exhibitor. Senior-Junior family partnerships will not be acceptable.

Qualification for Entry - To qualify for entry in the Junior All-Pennsylvania Contest, an animal must win first or second in a District, State or Regional Junior Show in the United States or as an alternative, if placing lower in such a show, must have placed first or second in the open class

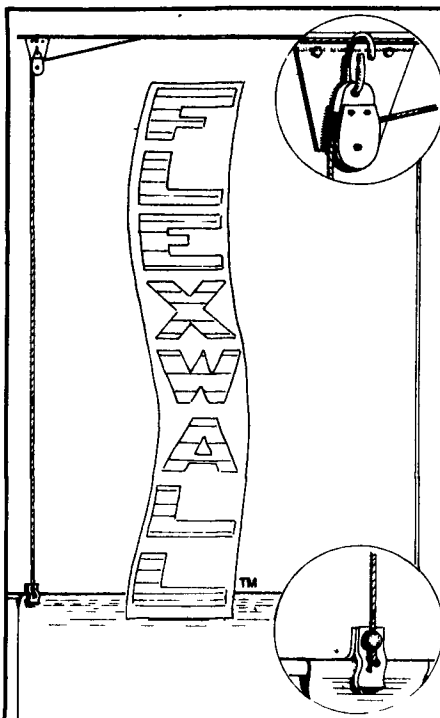
thereof. All entries must have competed in junior classes at their own county, district, state or regional show to establish their junior eligibility on their home grounds and regardless of winnings in open classes elsewhere. JUNIOR DIVISION PLACINGS AT THE THREE NATIONAL SHOWS WILL NOT QUALIFY AN ANIMAL.

Closing Date - Closing date for the receipt of entries in the Jr. All-PA Awards Contest is November

1. Entry is completed by submitting a suitable, professional picture of each eligible animal together with a completed entry blank. These pictures and entry blanks should be sent to the Pennsylvania Holstein Association, 839 Benner Pike, State College, PA 16801. Pictures 5x7 inches are preferred.

The Awards - All entries will be given consideration by the Junior All-PA Judging Committee.


