

Dutch Country Calf Sale Planned

LEESPORT (Berks Co.) — The Berks County Cattlemen's Association will be hosting the second annual Dutch Country Calf Sale on

Saturday, October 28. The sale will be held at the Lebanon Area Fairgrounds and will begin at 1:30 p.m. Auctioneer Harry Bachman

of Annville will be taking the bids. "This year's sale will feature another fine selection of Beef calves bred by local beef produc-

ers," said Sheila Miller, sale chairman. "A total of 30 head of crossbred and purebred steers and purebred heifers will be offered by 14 consignors."
