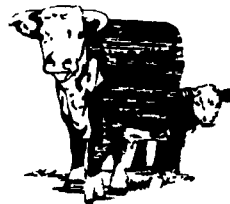

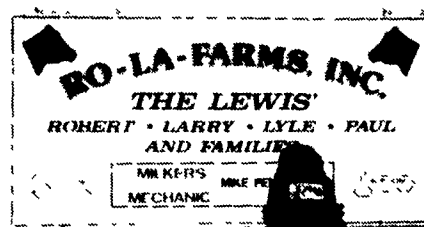

That's why we rely almost totally on corn silage for roughage in our herd - less than 3 lbs. of haylage is fed on a dry matter basis. "However, because we don't feed any hay, our ration requires a blend of solvent meal and SoyPLUS. We were feeding 70% solvent soybean meal and 30% SoyPLUS, but we recently switched to a 50/50 ratio and the cows are milking better. Our ration is balanced for 16 1/2% protein.

"In the past several months, our cows have been milking really well and production has been climbing. We're hopeful that we'll soon reach 26,000 lbs. of milk."
