WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; OCT. 19-25, 1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA SHOWED STEERS \$3.00-4.50 HIGHER AND HEIFERS UNEVEN \$2.00 HIGHER TO \$4.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00-3.00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00-4.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY 50 CENT TO \$9.00 HIGHER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER. **BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 2% BELOW** A WEEK AGO BUT 2% BELOW YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 13 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA WERE STEADY ON A STRONG MARKET AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS THE SAME AS LAST WEEK BUT 16% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 6 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE

\$2.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION, WAS 4% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 7% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOGS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY WITH LAST WEEK AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00-2.50 HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE VERY UNEVEN, \$2.00 HIGHER TO \$8.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.


