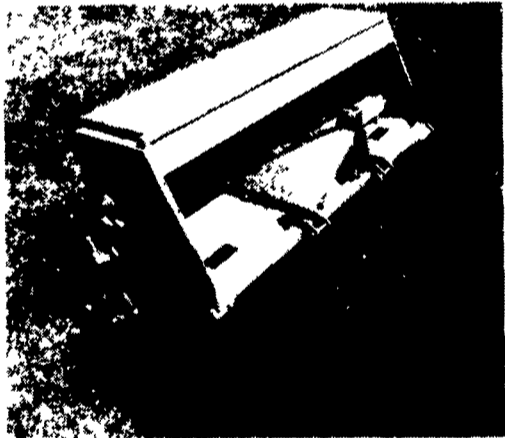

thrive. Production in 1988 in 28 major producing states has grown to a wholesale value of \$452.5 million. When imports are added, the total value reaches \$736 million. This is almost \$53 million more than 1987, and \$250 million more than 1984.

Roses clearly have the highest wholesale value of all the cut flower crops. In 1988, domestic production of roses was valued at \$181.9 million, almost three times carnations, the second highest. Chrysanthemums were the third highest, valued at \$51.9 million, just about \$10 million less than carnations.

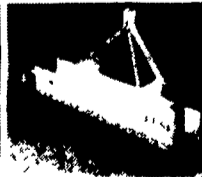

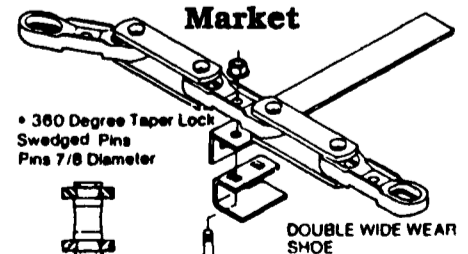
