More Producers **Raising Birds** For Hunting

UNIVERSITY PARK (Centre Co.) - More than 1,000 people in Pennsylvania now raise game birds. This is a ten-fold increase in the last 15 years. Pheasants, chukar, quail, wild turkey, mallard ducks, and a few rare breeds like ornamental pheasants or Hungarian partridge make up most of these birds.

Nearly all these people are parttime growers, a little more than a dozen farmers are full-time commercial game bird enterprises. Many hundred new part-time and full-time jobs have been created by this growing industry. Game bird growers tell us that producing birds is financially risky, biologically variable, and, in some cases, heartbreaking; but it is still exciting.

Penn State is sponsoring a conference on game birds which will be held February 25, 26, and 27, 1990 at the Holiday Inn, State College, Pennsylvania. This conference is usually attended by approximately 100 growers and hunting club operators from eight or so different states.
