Thursday, November 9, 1989 WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; NOV. 2-8, 1989. FREDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN, \$3.00 HIGHER TO \$2.00 LOWER WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.75-5.50 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, WITH COWS \$1.00-2.00 HIGHER AND BULLS WERE \$2.75 LOWER TO 75 CENT HIGHER. BEEF

PRODUCTION WAS 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND LESS THAN 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 19 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA WERE NOT QUOTED THIS WEEK BUT MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$6.00 LOWER. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 3% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 8% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, 50 CENT LOWER TO \$1.25 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00-2.25 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUC-

TION WAS 5% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 6% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVER-AGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 HIGH-ER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50-75 CENT HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$12.00 HIGHER **EXCEPT BELLIES WHICH WERE \$6.50** LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 5% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 7% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.






