MARKETS IN REVIEW; NOV. 9-15, 1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER WITH SOME WEAKNESS SHOWN IN LIGHT STEERS. MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED, \$3.50 HIGHER TO \$2.00 LOWER ON LIGHT CALVES.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-3.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 HIGHER MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.50 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 2% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 23 POUND HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.
