GRAIN PRICES MIXED ON WEDNESDAY FROM AREA TO AREA. EXPORT DEMAND FOR WHEAT CONTINUES VERY LIGHT. CORN PRICES HAD HIGHS AND LOWS DESPITE VERY GOOD EXPORT ACTIVITY. SOYBEAN PRICES MOSTLY LOWER EXCEPT IN ILLINOIS WHERE IT WAS SHARPLY HIGHER. CONCERNS OVER CONTINUED LACK OF A U.S.-U.S.S.R. AGREEMENT PRESURED SOYBEAN PRICES.
