SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.75-6.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENTS TO \$2.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$6.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-2.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUC-TION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 12 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.





