USDA DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN MARKET SUMMARY GRAIN PRICES MIXED ON WEDNESDAY. WHEAT PRICES HIGHER ON NEWS THAT U.S.S.R. WAS TARGETED FOR 2 MILLION TONS OF U.S. WHEAT UNDER EXPORT BONUS PROGRAM AND CHINA'S INTEREST IN 410,000 TONNES OF U.S. WHEAT UNDER EXPORT BONUS PROGRAM. CORN PRICES ADVANCED, STRENGTH CAME FROM NEWS THAT MEXICO IS IN THE MARKET FOR 200,000 TONNES OF U.S. CORN. SOYBEAN PRICES FELL, DESPITE SOME IMPROVED EXPORT INTEREST.

EXPORT NEWS: CHINA BOUGHT 125,000 TONNES HARD RED WINTER WHEAT FOR 89/90 MARKETING YEAR.

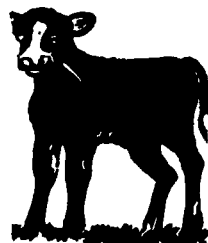
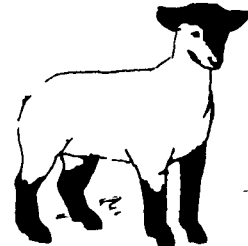
