WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; DEC.14-20,1989. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA SHOWED **STEERS UNEVEN \$1.50 LOWER TO** \$7.75 HIGHER, HEIFERS WERE 25 CENT TO \$2.00 LOWER WHILE MID-WEST PRICES WERE 75 CENT TO \$5.75 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED \$2.25 LOWER TO \$2.50 HIGHER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY \$1.50-2.25 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA HAD COWS \$2.50-3.00 HIGHER WHILE BULLS WERE \$3.75-5.00 LOW-ER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS THE SAME AS LAST WEEK BUT 3% HIGH-ER THAN A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 10 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA WERE NOT ESTABLISHED THIS WEEK AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE

MOSTLY STEADY. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 4% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 18% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE 75 CENT TO \$3.75 LOWER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE 75 CENT TO \$4.50 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 10% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.50 HIGH-ER FOLLOWING THE MIDWEST PRICES WHICH WAS 50 CENT TO \$1.50 HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE \$1.50-19.50 HIGHER EXCEPT HAMS WHICH WERE \$20.00-23.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 7% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 6% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.


