

## Vegetable Growers Will Meet At Trump's

BRIDGETON, NJ. — After many successful annual meetings at Resorts International, the Vegetable Growers Association of New Jersey (VGANJ) is moving their 1990 meeting to Trump Castle hotel and casino.

Plans are being completed to host more than 2,000 people, including growers, agribusiness professionals and state and university specialists from New Jersey and the eastern U.S.

During the two days of meetings, they listened to reports from Dairymen's directors and top management on the cooperative's successes the past fiscal year and the challenges and opportunities for members and their co-op this fiscal year.

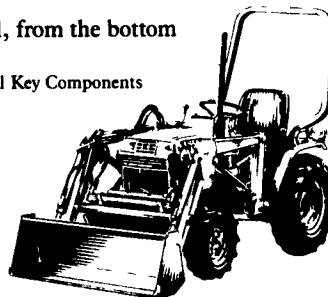
