At 209.4 bushels per acre, M. Lamar Miller, Manheim, Lancaster County, topped the Pennsylvania Five-Acre Corn Club's annual contest. Miller's yields with Cargill 7877 in this less than ideal growing year was the only record over 200 bushels per acre. This top record came in the ear regular harvest class.

Scott Shoop, Milton, Northumberland County, had the champion in the shelled regular harvest class. His Pioneer 3352 yielded 189.9 bushels per acre.

In the shelled three-acre harvest class, John A. McDowell, Mercer, Mercer County, was champion with a yield of 196.2 bushels per acre from Pioneer 3475.




