MARKETS IN REVIEW; JAN. 11-17, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-4.50 LOW-ER WITH HEIFERS SHOWNING SOME STRENGTH. MIDWEST PRICES WERE 25 CENT TO \$2.75 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA HAD NO COMPARI-SON WITH LAST WEEK BUT HAD A STEADY UNDERTONE AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO WEAK.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA
HAD COWS \$1.00 LOWER AND
BULLS \$2.00 TO \$3.75 HIGHER AS
MIDWEST MARKETS WERE ALSO

MIXED, 50 CENT LOWER TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 10% HIGHER THAN A WEEK AGO BUT 3% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA AND NATIONALLY DID NOT SELL ENOUGH AT ANY ONE TIME TO ESTABLISH A MARKET. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 6% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 21% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 11 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE

MIXED, \$1.00 LOWER TO \$3.00 HIGH-AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-6.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUC-TION WAS 15% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 23% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.75 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE \$2.50-5.50 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 32% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 2% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.

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
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


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
