• Descendants of the ancient and legendary Africans known to outsiders as Pygmies, the seminomadic Efe carry on a tradition of hunting and gathering little affected by the modern world, says National Geographic.

One of the world's largest populations of hunter-gatherers. some 150,000 to 200,000 Pygmies remain scattered across seven African countries, says National Geographic.

• The term Pygmy, considered derisive by the African people it purports to describe, comes from the Greek word "pygme," a unit of length defining the distance from the elbow to the knuckles, says National Geographic.

• Pygmies have always been considered the original inhabitants of the African rain forest, hunting and gathering for hundreds or even thousands of generations before agriculturists arrived, says National Geographic.

• The foraging ways of the Efe, short-statured African people widely known as Pygmies, may be similar to human existence prior to the introduction of agriculture some 10,000 years ago, says National Geographic.

• The Efe, descendants of the ancient Africans known to outsiders as Pygmies, firmly believe that white people cat black people and find children especially appetizing, says National Geographic.

· Renowned as archers, the efe, short-statured African people widely known as Pygmies, pursue more than 45 different animals for meat, says National Geographic.
