Thursday, February 1, 1990 WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; JAN. 25-31, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.50 LOWER WITH HEAVY HEIFERS SHOWING SOME STRENGTH AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE UNEVEN, \$1.00 HIGHER TO \$1.00 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$5.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY \$1.75-8.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50-2.50 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUC-TION WAS 8% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVER-AGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA WERE STEADY WHILE MID-WEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY. VEAL AND CALF PRODUC-TION WAS 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 15% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 23 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE

50 CENT LOWER AS THE MIDWEST MARKET WAS UNEVEN, \$2.00 HIGH-ER TO \$1,00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUC-TION WAS 3% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 8% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVER-AGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50-2.00 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$9.00 HIGHER EXCEPT BELLIES WHICH WERE \$5.75-6.75 LOWER. HOG PRO-DUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 4% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. A VERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.
