To help celebrate the event, the Pennsylvania Beef Council is distributing new point-of-purchase promotion material to more than 1,500 stores throughout the state. This year an ethnic flavor promotes Chinese, Italian, and Mexican dishes "Made Easy With Beef.'

Retailers will advertise beef with colorful posters, mobiles, case cards, recipes, and rail strips designed to encourage consumers

to try new and different ways to prepare beef. "The emphasis is on variety and convenience," said Leon Acrich, beef and veal retail coordinator for the Pennsylvania Beef Council

Information Resources, Inc., a independent research firm, concluded in a recent survey that point-of-purchase materials were effective in generating, on average, a three to five percent increase in fresh beef sales. "Considering the volume of beef sold in the supermarket, a five percent gain in beef sales can make a significant impact on overall profitability in the store," said Acrich.

A blitz of beef checkoff-funded television, radio, and print advertising will bring the importance of beef into consumers' homes during the National Meat Month.

The ads are part of the coordinated month-long promotion to educate consumers about leaner meats and stimulate greater meat sales. In addition to the media blitz, the Pennsylvania Beef Council is conducting numerous in-store cooking demonstrations in retail stores throughout the

The Pennsylvania Beef Council's retail promotions are just part of a coordinated beef and veal marketing plan funded by producers through the \$1 per head beef checkoff program.




