USDA DAILY NATIONAL GRAIN MARKET SUMMARY WHEAT PRICES LOWER, CORN AND SOYBEAN PRICES HIGHER ON WEDNESDAY. DESPITE EGYPT'S WHEAT PURCHASE AND RUMORS THAT RUSSIA AND/OR CHINA MAY BE IN THE MARKET, WHEAT PRICES FELL, FOLLOWING SHOWERS FROM TEXAS ACROSS THE CENTRAL PLAINS. THE MAJOR FACTOR IN WHEAT PRICE TRENDS OVER THE NEXT COUPLE OF DAYS WILL BE ACTUAL PRECIPITATION VERSUS EXPECTATION. CORN AND SOYBEAN PRICES UP SLIGHTLY. FRIDAY'S SUPPLY AND DEMAND REPORT PUSHED CORN PRICES HIGHER. SOYBEAN PRICES SUPPORTED BY IMPROVED EXPORT DEMAND.

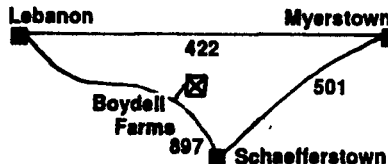
