SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.25 HIGH-ER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-1.75 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.25-2.75 LOWER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-2.00 HIGH-ER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 6% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

**VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-**NIA WERE STEADY FOLLOWING MIDWEST PRICES WHICH WERE ALSO STEADY. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 5% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 15% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGED DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.
