CASH AND FUTURES PRICES CLOSED MIXED ON WEDNESDAY. WHEAT PRICES MIXED. EXPORT INTEREST IMPROVED FOR HARD WHEAT AND SPECULATORS STARTED TAKING LONG LIQUIDATIONS BEFORE POSSIBLE DELIVERIES, ADDING STRENGTH TO HARD WHEAT WHILE OTHERS SHOWED MOSTLY DECLINES. WET CONDITIONS AND FORECAST FOR CONTINUED PRECIPITATION, PRESSURED CORN AND SOYBEAN PRICES LIGHT EXPORT DEMAND AND LACK OF RUSSIAN CORN DEMAND ALSO FACTORS IN THE DECLINES

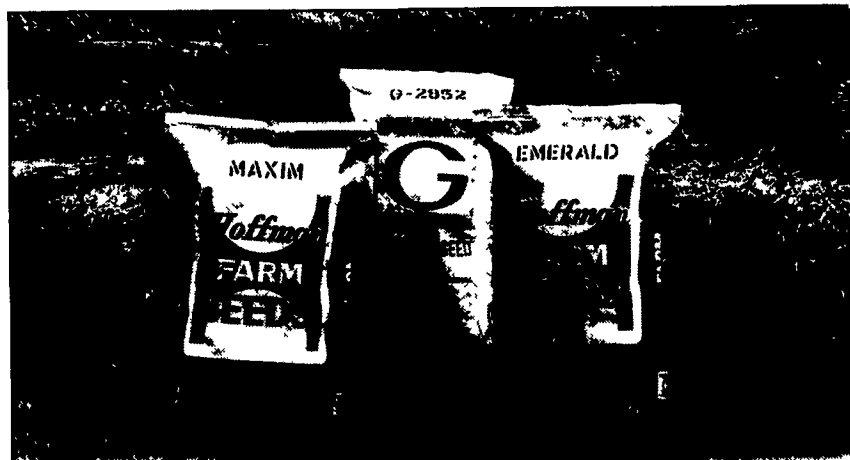

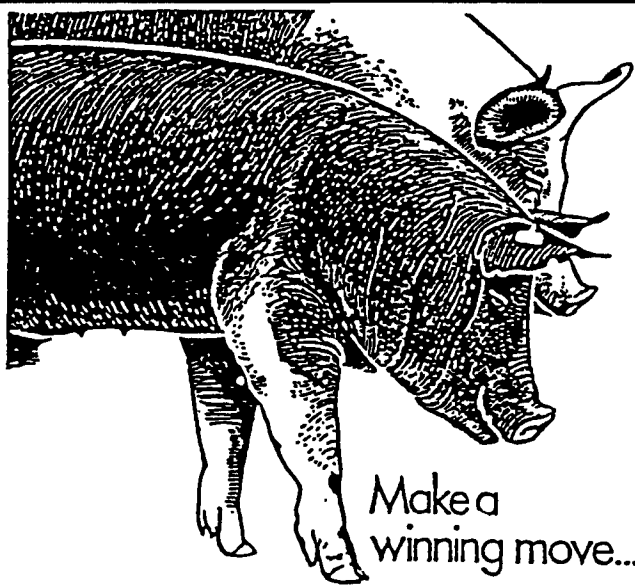
