MARKETS IN REVIEW; MARCH -14, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA HAD STEERS STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER AND HEIF-ERS 50 CENT TO \$2.00 HIGHER. MID-WEST PRICES WERE MIXED ALSO AT \$2.00 LOWER TO \$2.50 HIGHER

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO

\$2.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WER \$1.50 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3 50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00 HIGH-ER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 3% ABOVE A YEAR AGO AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 11 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO WEAK. VEAL AND CALF PRO-**DUCTION WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK** AGO BUT 17% BELOW A YEAR AGO AVERAGED DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED \$3.00 LOWER TO \$2.50 HIGH-**ER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00** HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 9% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO


