PFA Pushes For Deposit On Cans, Bottles

guide the General Assembly in handling the issue. PFA, according to a 1990 Priority Issues statement, supports the "passage of legislation that would encourage the use of returnable or biodegradable packaging and would require fast food outlets to only use biodegradable food containers."

But Eckel insists that the passage of the Solid Waste Planning Recycling and Waste Reduction Act in Pennsylvania will not "solve all of your problems regarding trash being dumped in your fields."

"The recycling act is important but it's not going to reach into the countryside to solve our problem," he said. Communities of 5,000 to 10,000 people and a population density greater than 300 per square mile will be involved in the protection of wetlands is a far more complex issue than many would let

programs of reducing solid waste thorough recycling.

"That's about 400-plus communities, but that also eliminates many rural Pennsylvanians," Eckel said. "Even if it reached into the countryside, recycling does not solve the problem of bottles and cans being dumped in our fields."

Deposit on bottles, cans

Eckel insists that a deposit on bottles and cans "would provide that incentive" to help curb the dumping problem. He urged voters to "express themselves at the polling place" in the referendum.

The PFA is concerned with wetlands preservation, and is urging the passage of S.B. 1326 to establish a comprehensive wetlands preservation program in Pennsylvania.

"The PFA contends that the you believe," said Eckel. He spoke about the so-called "destructors" of wetlands.

"Those organizations, including PFA, and persons who support S.B. 1326, legislation designed to develop a comprehensive wetlands preservation program in Pennsylvania," he said.

According to PFA, provisions of the bill important to agriculture would establish a Wetlands Trust to purchase "exceptional value" or important wetlands. Provisions would allow permit waivers for limited value wetlands.

The legislation would establish timetables for decisions on permit applications and would allow wetlands used for agriculture within the past 25 years to be put back into farming, according to PFA.
