FEEDER STEER DEMAND CLOSED GOOD DESPITE TUESDAY'S DOWNWARD ADJUSTMENT OF THE C.M.E. STOCKER TRADING UNEVEN WITH LESS DEPTH IN GRAZER BUYING RANKS THAN IN RECENT WEEKS. FEEDER CATTLE FLESH CONDITIONS REMAIN ATTRACTIVE FOR MAY, LARGELY SLIGHTLY THIN THROUGH MODERATELY FLESHY, WITH MODERATELY FLESHY CATTLE MORE RESPONSIBLE FOR LOWER END OF QUOTES THAN WEIGHT.
