Delaware 4-H

Delaware 4-H will use a grant from Bob Evans Farms Inc./Owens Country Sausage to sponsor an educational field trip to Hatfield Quality Meats, Hatfield Packing Co., in Lansdale, Pa. The grant program, designed to enlighten 4-H members to the pork industry, is coordinated by the National 4-H Council, a not-

for-profit organization that uses private resources to support 4-H.

4-H members and project leaders will tour the processing company and hear presentations about current marketing trends in the pork industry and a new grading system used to determine payments to pork producers.

In response to consumer demand for lean pork products, the company developed a method of determining payment to pork producers based on carcass merit evaluation, as well as live weight of the hog. The percentages of fat and lean are measured and compared to a company standard. Producers with carcasses above the standard receive bonuses while those below the standard are penalized.

which she walked for several weeks before she consulted a doctor.

"Sure," she admitted. "At my age, I have some creaks and stiffness, but I laugh about it and keep busy. I try to keep a good outlook."

All those years of working on the farm engraved the getting-up-early habit within her. Bedtime is generally 11:00 p.m.

"There's always so much to do," she said.

If it isn't a sewing project, it's quilting or cross stitching or a craft project or freezing produce from their big garden or helping to cook for the Lebanon County Beagle Club, where her husband is a mem-

ber, or a meeting with the pinocle club or bowling team.

Ruth keeps few of her projects for herself. Instead she gives them to friends or as fundraisers to non-profit organizations.

Ruth's mother died at age 96. She also was an accomplished seamstress and often sewed for others.

"Even in the nursing home, she was still hemming dresses until the end," Ruth said. "And I hope to do that also."

A bit shy about being interviewed for a newspaper article, Ruth said, "I'm nothing special, really. I'm just ordinary."

But to Karen, her mother is the greatest — and that's what really counts.
