IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY
\$2.00-5.50 HIGHER, AS MIDWEST
PRICES WERE \$4.50-9.50 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$2.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.25-1.50 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA HAD COWS 75 CENT TO \$1.50 HIGHER WHILE BULLS WERE 50 CENT TO \$3.75 LOWER. MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 5% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 13 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

THERE WERE TOO FEW VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA TO QUOTE A MARKET THIS WEEK, MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 7% BELOW A WEEK AGO. AND 15% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 11 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-2.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-3.25 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 5% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 6% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE

SAME AS LAST YEAR.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO 50 CENTHIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-1.50 HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE VERY UNEVEN \$5.00 LOWER TO \$13.00 HIGHER WITH BELLIES NOT BEING TESTED. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 9% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.


