WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; MAY 10-16, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN \$2.50 LOWER TO \$4.00 HIGHER FOLLOWING MIDWEST PRICES WHICH WERE ALSO UNEVEN, \$8.25 HIGHER TO \$3.50 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.50 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$1.25 LOWER TO \$3.75 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE ALSO MIXED, 75 CENT LOWER TO \$1.50 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 10% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND

3% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 8 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.00-11.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$11.00 LOWER. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 7% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 22% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 7 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.
