May 31, 1990 MARKETS IN REVIEW; MAY 23-30, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE VERY **UNEVE1500 HIGHER AS MIDWEST** PRICES WERE \$1.75-3.50 LOWER.

THERE WERE NO SALES IN VIRGI-NIA THIS WEEK FOR SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS WHILE MID-WEST PRICES WERE 25 CENT TO \$2.25 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$3.50 LOWER TO \$3.25 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$2.50 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 1% BELOW A

WEEK AGO BUT 2% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA WERE STEADY FOLLOWING MIDWEST PRICES WHICH WERE STEADY TO FIRM. CALF AND VEAL PRODUCTION WAS 4% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 20% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 12 POUNDS LIGHT-ER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.25-5.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$3.00-4.00 HIGHER WITH CONSIDERABLE WEAKNESS SHOWN TOWARD THE END OF THE

WEEK. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 7% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 2% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE \$1.50 LOWER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.50 HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$5.00 HIGHER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 6% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE THE SAME AS LAST YEAR.
