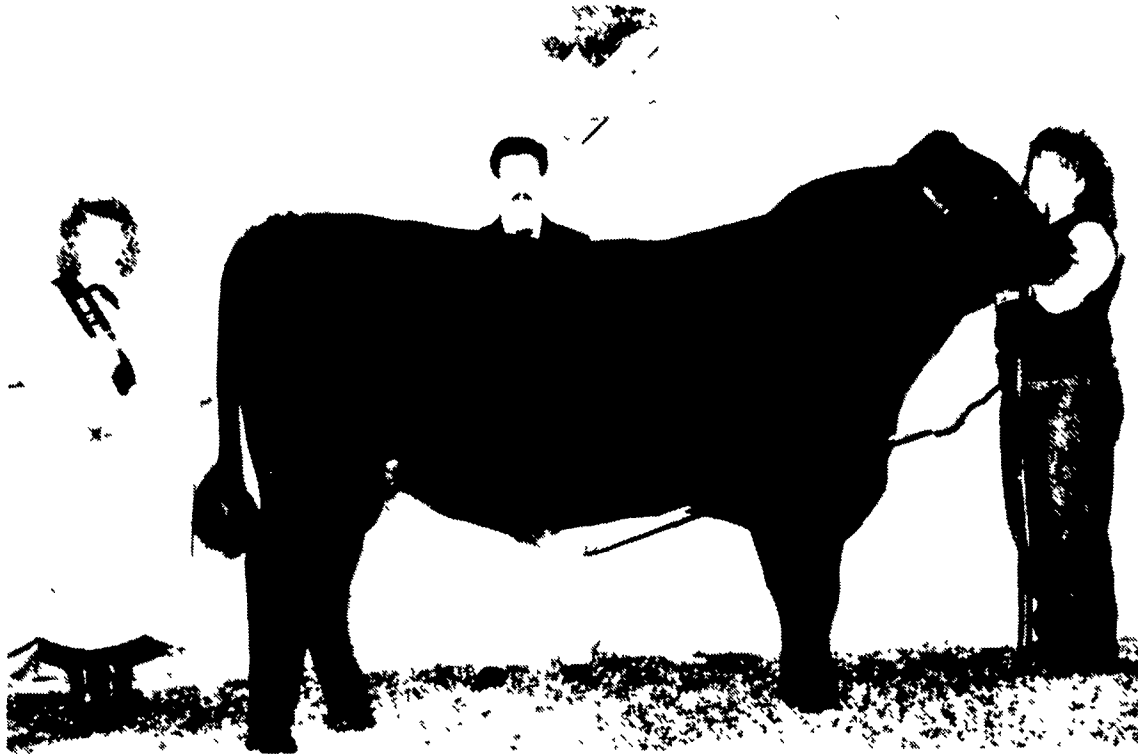


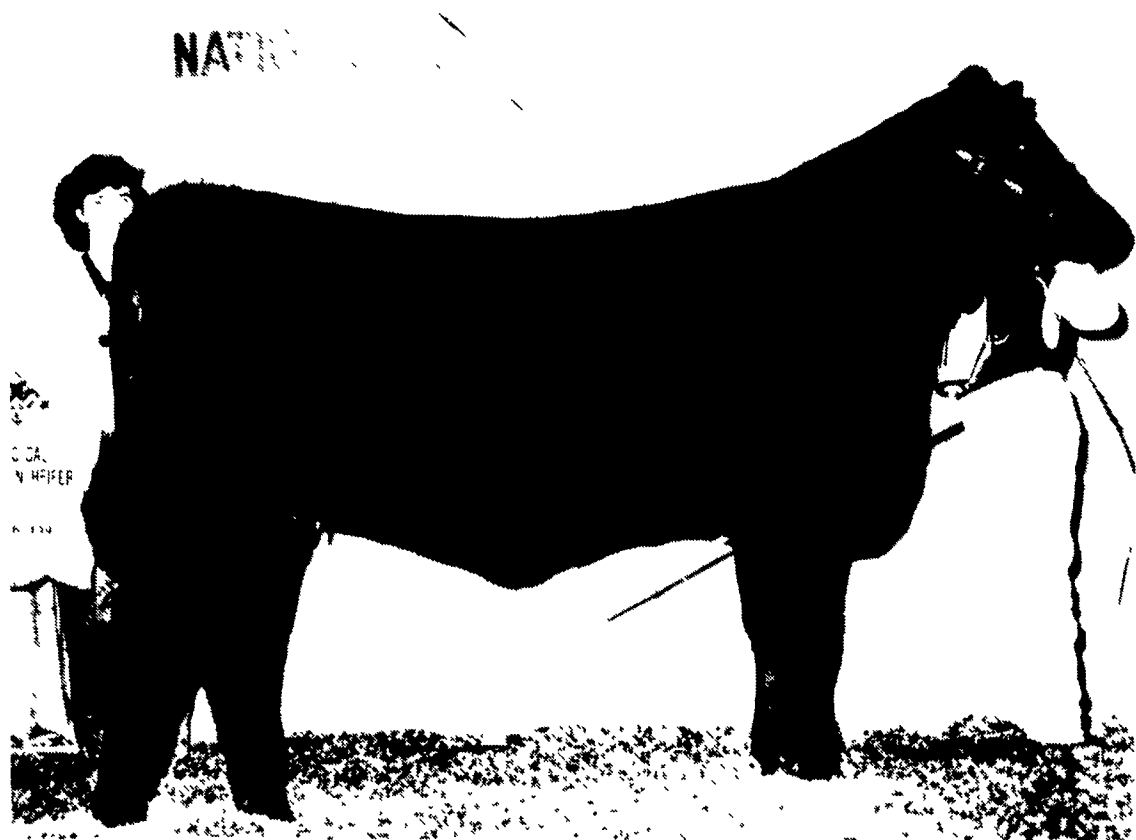
Youngsters Parade 168 Head At Angus Show



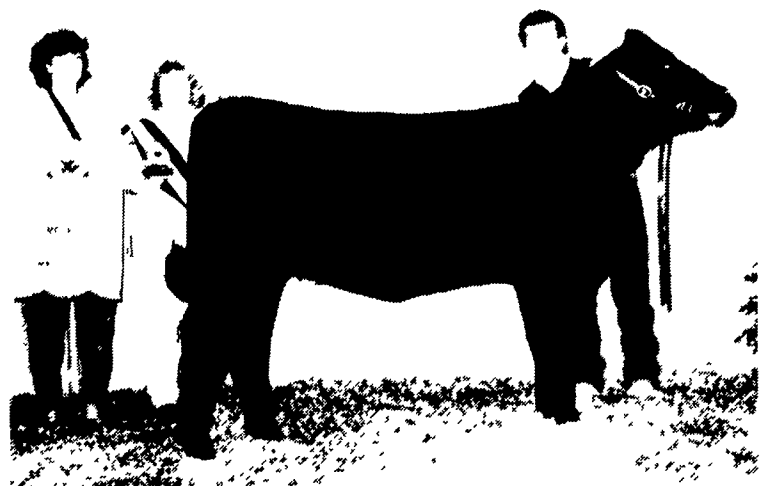

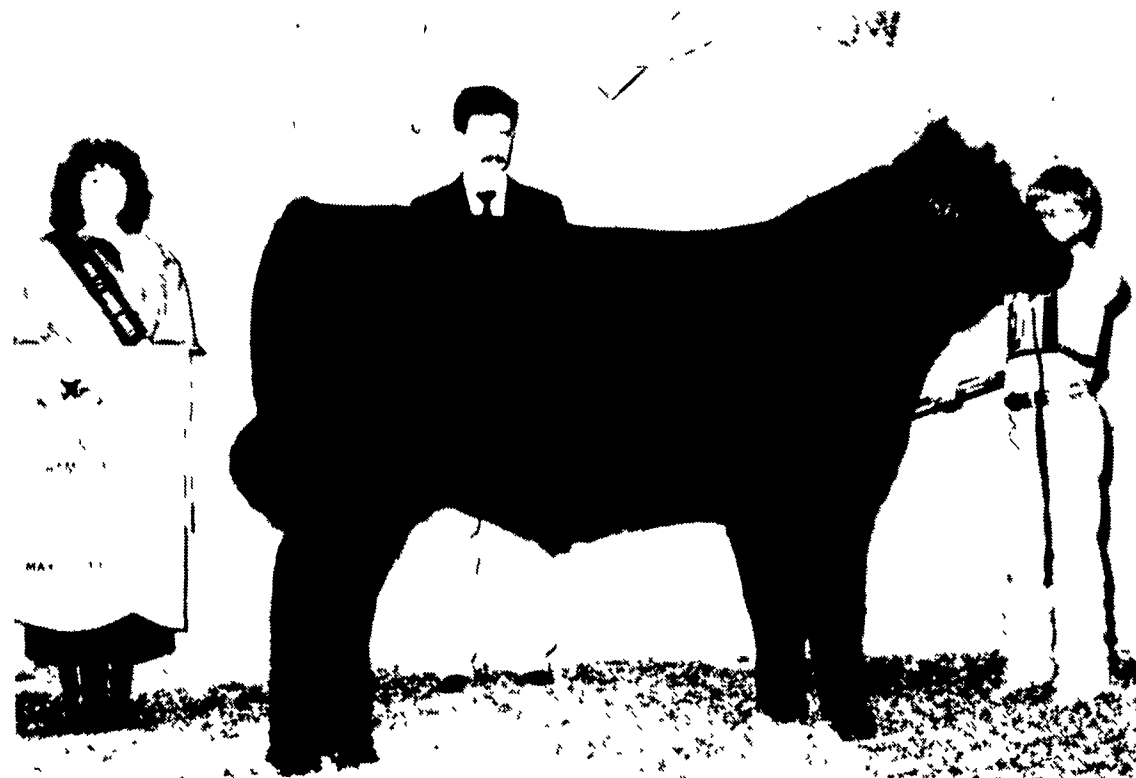

D A Ashley 5193 was selected as the bred-and-owned reserve summer heifer calf champion at the show. Shown by Mark Moxley, West Friendship, Maryland; the heifer is a June 1989 daughter of Brost Dan Patch.



Chad Goodman, Sycamore, Ohio, exhibited the grand champion steer at the 1990 Atlantic National Junior Angus Show. The steer is H B W Express 129, a May 1989 son of R&J Taurus 1186.

TIMONIUM, Md.— Young Angus exhibitors paraded 168 head of cattle around the showing ring to vie for championship honors at the recent Atlantic National Junior Angus Show at the state fairgrounds.

Judge Craig Wallace of Knob Noster, MO, placed classes and picked winners for the divisions of bred-and-owned heifers, "owned" heifers, bred-and-owned bulls, cow/calf pairs, and registered steers.

Grand champion honors in the bred-and-owned heifer division went to the spring calf winner, Kruegers Belladonna, shown by Erin Krueger, Coatesville. This heifer is a March 1989 daughter of Grubbs MacKenzie. Mark Moxley, West Friendship, MD, led out the reserve grand champion female in this division. D A Fairlea 4295, a February 1989, Grubbs

MacKenzie daughter, was earlier named reserve spring calf champion.

L A F Felicia 8905 won grand champion laurels in the "owned" heifer category for exhibitor Ty Krebs, Gordon, NE. This May 1989 heifer sired by Grubbs MacKenzie was also named summer calf champion. Knapp Moxie won both the "owned" spring calf and reserve grand champion female banners for Shelley Weaver, Brimfield, IL. Her heifer is a March 1989 daughter of Grubbs MacKenzie.

Judge Wallace awarded Jennifer Calderazzo, York, with bred-and-owned grand champion bull honors. Her champion, J L C Mac Babet, is a February 1989 son of Grubbs MacKenzie. The reserve rosette was presented to Jason Goff, Norwich, OH, for his entry J (Turn to Page D3)
