WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; MAY 31-JUNE 6, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$3.00 HIGHER TO \$3.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.75-5.75 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE UNEVEN, \$1.00 HIGHER TO \$1.00 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 11% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 1% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY FOLLOWING MIDWEST PRICES WHICH WERE ALSO STEADY. CALF AND VEAL PRODUCTION WAS 14% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 24% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 21% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 6 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 25 CENT HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE \$3.50-8.00 HIGHER EXCEPT LOINS WHICH WERE \$11.00-14.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS 21% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 9% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.
