WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; JUNE 14-20, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$7.50 LOWER TO \$6.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.50 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.25-2.25 HIGHER AS AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO 50 CENT LOWER. COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$4.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 3% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 1% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$11.00 LOWER. CALF AND VEAL PRODUCTION WAS 3% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 11% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-1.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-3.75 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 23% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.
