

MARKETS IN REVIEW; JUNE 21-27, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$3.00-4.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00-3.00 HIGHER WITH BEST INTEREST ON HEAVIER FEEDERS. SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE NOT FULLY TESTED WITH MIDWEST PRICES \$1.00-2.00 LOWER. COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY,

BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 1% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE UNCHANGED FROM LAST YEAR.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY AS EAST COAST CARCASS PRICES WERE STEADY TO WEAK. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 3% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 10% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 18 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE

\$3.00-4.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00-4.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 11% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 10% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES CLOSED STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. PORK PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 HIGHER THAN A WEEK AGO.
