Ask the Old Farmer: The leaves on my houseplants have begun to droop and yellow What's going on? TJ, NJ begun to droop and yellow vynat S going on A, , . . , If you haven't been overwatering them, yellow leaves might indicate iron deficiency A good source of slow-release iron is one or two rusty nails pushed into the soil

Home Hints: Remove all traces of the leaves when preparing rhubarb, as the leaves are extremely toxic Remember to wash hands and utensils thoroughly afterwards




