WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; JUN 28-JULY 3, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-5.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES HAD STEERS STEADY AND HEIFERS \$1.00-2.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA THIS WEEK HAD TOO FEW TO ESTIMATE A TREND WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO WEAK.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO \$3.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$3.00-6.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 23 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.00-3.75 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$10.50 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.
