MARKETS IN REVIEW; JULY 5-11, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE UNEVEN, \$4.00 LOWER TO \$5.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$3.00-7.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY FOLLOWING THE MIDWEST WHICH WAS STEADY TO 50 CENT HIGHER. COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$4.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO FIRM. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 18% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS LIGHTER.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE FIRM AS MIDWEST

PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 39% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 35% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 28 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.25-2.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED, \$1.00 LOWER TO \$6.00 HIGHER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 12% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 5% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 6 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$20.00 HIGHER. PORK PRODUCTION WAS 14% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND LESS

THAN 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 4 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

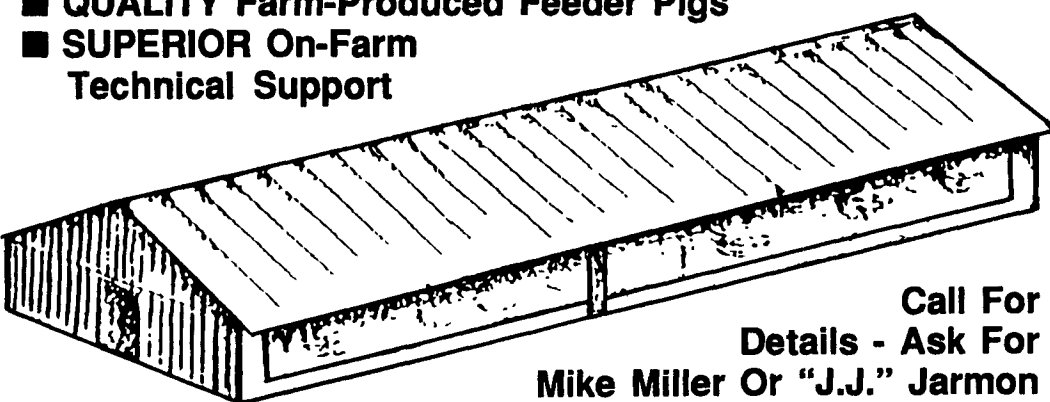
