

LOUISVILLE, Ky.— Six breeds of dairy cattle will walk before the judges and before a buying public at the 1990 North American International Livestock Exposition.

The animals will be presented in a wide variety of shows, some of them regional or national. Open shows and junior shows also will be held.

"These are the top dairy cattle in the nation," said Harold Workman, executive director of the North American International Livestock Exposition (NAILE).

"So you know you can earn a pretty good dollar when you sell here anyway. But taking top honors in a show -- that can push your sale prices way up."

Producers of every major breed of dairy cattle will have ample opportunity to put their animals on display. Shows and sales scheduled for the November 3-6 dairy cattle portion of the NAILE are: All American Junior Jersey Show; All American Jersey Show; National Jersey Jug Futurity; All American Jersey Sale; Jersey Pot O' Gold Sale; National Junior

Guernsey Show; Guernsey Gold Futurity; National Guernsey Show; North American Guernsey Showcase Sale; Southern National Junior Ayrshire Show; Southern National Ayrshire Show; Junior Brown Swiss Show; Southeastern National Brown Swiss Show; Winter National Junior Milking Shorthorn Show; Winter National Open Milking Shorthorn Show; Junior Holstein Show; Holstein Open Show; and the North American Classic Holstein Sale.

In addition to the shows and sales, the North American Interna-

tional is host to a number of special events. They include the 4-H Dairy Quiz Bowl; the Junior Dairy Banquet and Funfest; and the Youth, Junior College and Senior Collegiate Dairy Judging Contests and their awards breakfasts.

"What we have here is three action-packed days," Workman said. "After all, we have seven national shows. And these kids who compete in the contests -- they earned the right to be here."

They'll be outstanding contributors to the livestock industry someday."

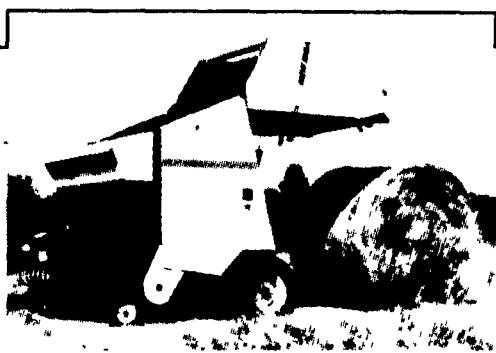
