WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; JULY 12-18, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$5.00 LOWER TO \$5.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MOSTLY \$1.50-3.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$1.25 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE \$2.00-6.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 21% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO FIRM. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 53% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 19% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 30 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED 50 CENT HIGHER TO \$2.50 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 28% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 13%


