CASH GRAIN PRICES MOSTLY LOWER WEDNESDAY. LACK OF EXPORT ORDERS PRESSURED PRICES. WINTER WHEAT HARVEST OVER 80 PERCENT FINISHED WITH SMALL DELAYS MAINLY IN SOFT RED STATES. THE OVERALL CONDITION OF WHEAT IS GOOD. POOR QUALITY WHEAT IS BEING PUSHED RAPIDLY INTO FEED RATIONS DUE TO THE RELATIONSHIP BETWEEN WHEAT AND CORN PRICES. FAVORABLE GROWING WEATHER CONTINUES AND FORECAST FOR RAIN ALSO FACTORS FOR CORN AND SOYBEAN DECLINES.

Whole breasts were plentiful on white supplies while yellow stocks were generally noted as in much better balance and less freely available. Legs were fully adequate to ample with light trading noted as low as 29 to 30 cents. Leg quarters were in best demand with the bulk of new business at higher price levels. Wings were about adequate at unchanged prices. Giblets were less available and generally no more than adequate. Drums and thighs were adequate and in fairly good balance.
