MARKETS IN REVIEW; JULY 19-24, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER AS MID-WEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-5.00 HIGH-ER.

NO SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS WERE REPORTED IN VIRGI-NIA THIS WEEK BUT THE MIDWEST PRICES WERE 50 CENT TO \$2.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED \$4.00 LOWER TO \$10.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE ALSO MIXED, 50 CENT HIGHER TO \$3.00 LOWER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 2% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA FOLLOWED MIDWEST PRICES AND WERE MOSTLY STEADY. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 19% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 32 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.25 LOWER.

LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO BUT 22% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 6 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIR-GINIA WERE 50 CENT LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$2.00-2.50 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE \$1.00-15.00 LOWER, HOG PRODUC-TION WAS 3% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 3% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 7 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO
