WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; AUG. 9-15, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA FOLLOWED MIDWEST PRICES AND WERE VERY UNEVEN, \$2.00 LOWER TO \$4.00 HIGHER, MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$9.00 LOWER TO \$6.00 HIGHER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$2.00 LOWER TO \$3.50 HIGHER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.75 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA HAD COWS \$4.50-5.00 LOWER AND BULLS \$2.50-4.25 HIGHER, MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-2.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 5% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 5% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 10 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO WEAK. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 3% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 9% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 28 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE \$1.00-2.75 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE 75 CENT TO \$2.00 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS

2% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

SLAUGHTER HOG PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE 50 CENT TO 75 CENT LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-1.25 LOWER. FRESH PORK PRICES WERE MIXED, \$5.00 HIGHER TO \$7.00 LOWER. HOG PRODUCTION WAS LESS THAN 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 6% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGED DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 3 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

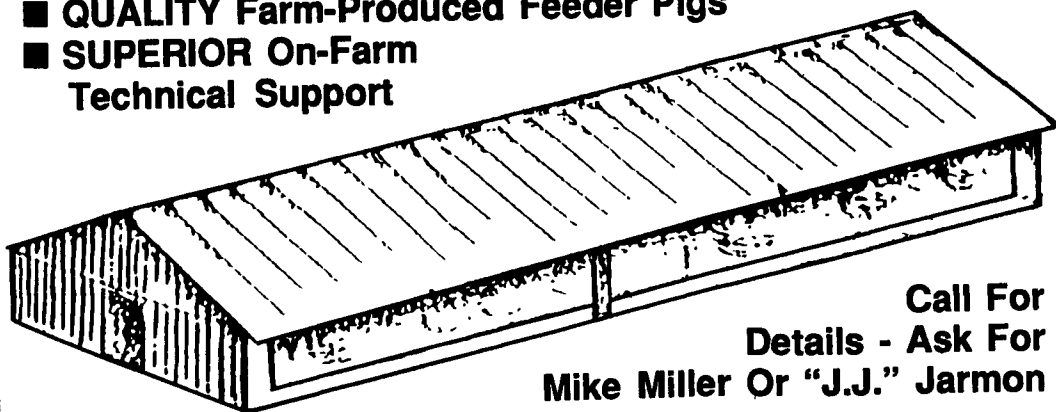
