MARKETS IN REVIEW; AUG.16-22, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA UNEVEN, 50 CENT HIGHER TO \$3.50 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$9.50 LOWER.

SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$4.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MIXED, \$6.00 HIGHER TO \$4.25 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 1% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 1% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 7 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE WEAK AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE UNEVEN, \$3.00 HIGHER TO \$6.00 LOWER. VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 1% BELOW A WEEK AGO AND 2% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 35 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.
