Eastern Milk Holds Meeting

SYRACUSE, N.Y. — Eastern Milk Producers Cooperative will hold its annual business meeting and delegate meeting Sept. 27-28 at the Sheraton University Inn in Syracuse.

About 600 farmers and industry guests are expected to attend. The farmer-delegates will be representing 2,800 farm families in nine states.

A press briefing/lunch will get under way at 11:45 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 27, for members of the news media.

The open annual business meeting will start at 1 p.m.

Several officers will report on the operational and financial per-

formance of the co-op, and future plans. They include: President Lewis Gardner, a dairy farmer from Galeton, Pa.; Vice President Timothy Bryant, who farms in Pawlet, Vt.; Secretary C. Lee Greenwalt, who runs a dairy in Lawrenceville, Pa., and Treasurer George E. Mesick Jr., a dairy farmer from South Schodack, N.Y.

Also, board member Robert Gabel of Newport, Pa., will report on a major restructuring of the dis-

tricts within the co-op, and board member Noel Davis of Unadilla, N.Y., will discuss membership trends.

A number of awards, including the Top Ten Quality Farmers, will highlight the annual banquet, which will get under way at 6:30 p.m., Sept. 27.

Eastern is a Syracuse-based dairy co-op with facilities in New York, Pennsylvania, Vermont and Delaware.


