WEEKLY REVIEW IN VIRGINIA MARKETS IN REVIEW; SEPT. 13-19, 1990. FEEDER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$3.25 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER. SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIFERS IN VIRGINIA WERE NEAR STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1 00-2.00 HIGHER. COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE 25 CENT TO \$5.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-1.50 HIGHER. BEEF PRODUCTION WAS 17% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 1% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE

DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 2 POUNDS LIGHTER THAN A YEAR AGO. VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE GENERALLY STEADY VEAL AND CALF PRODUCTION WAS 20% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 7% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 32 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO. LAMB PRICES IN VIRGINIA WERE STEADY TO \$2.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE MIXED, \$1.00 HIGHER TO \$2.25 LOWER. LAMB PRODUCTION WAS 24% ABOVE A WEEK AGO AND 8% ABOVE A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

HOG PRODUCTION WAS 22% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 4% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 5 POUNDS HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO. 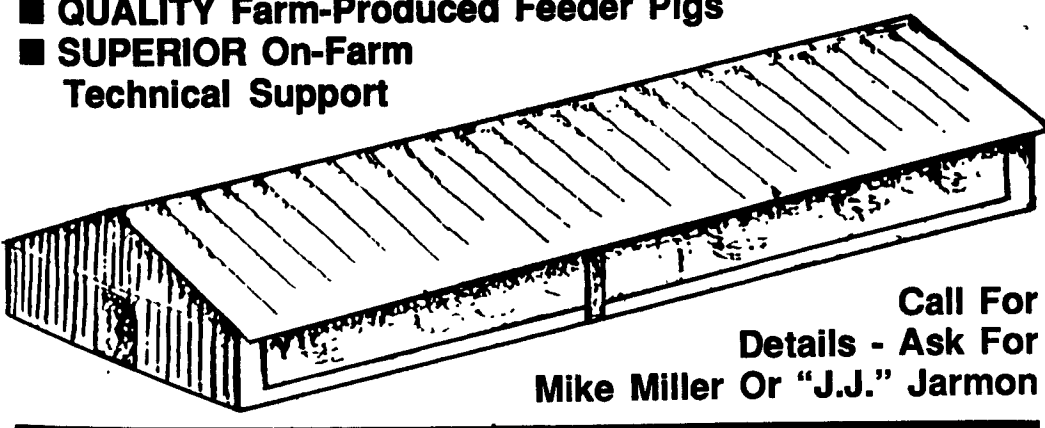

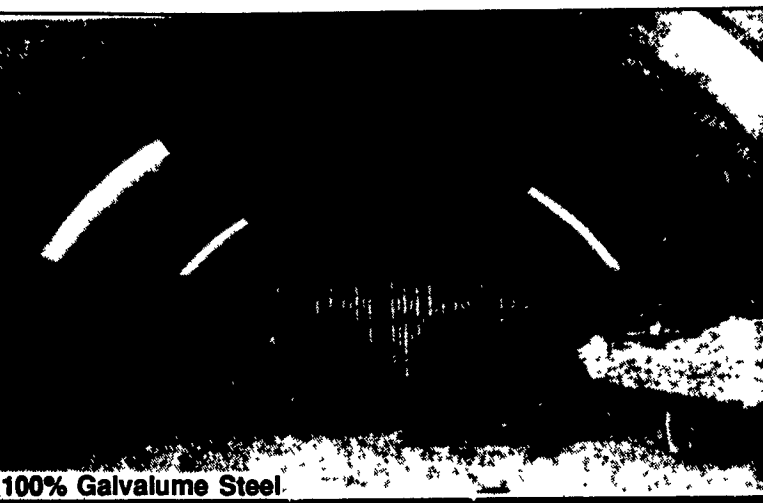
