Penn State Cooperative Extension is sponsoring "Designer Details Made Easy," a new three-hour sewing seminar from Palmer/Plestch. The seminar will be presented by Kathleen Spike, a popular speaker throughout the U.S., Canada and Australia. She also runs her own dressmaking business and sewing school, and is the author of two books.

Ms. Spike will demonstrate time-saving ideas for better sewing results in half the time; share changes in fashion and technology; show how to recreate designer looks at a fraction of the price; talk about fresh ideas on pattern changes; show new waistline treatments and tips on why, when and where to use a serger.

You will also discover how to choose patterns that flatter your figure. Learn how to get good results with fusible interfacings, pressing principles, shoulder pads and when to wear them, bias cuts and bias bindings, and how to

select no-fail fabrics.

You will also be able to watch a fashion forecast and trunk show including the "Perfect Fall Jacket," "Perfect Trousers," and easy "flash of color" blouse and top ideas.

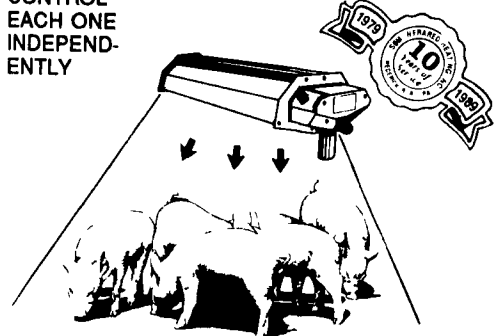
