WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER. SLAUGHTER STEERS AND HEIF-ERS IN VIRGINIA NOT FULLY TESTED, WHILE MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 HIGHER.

COWS AND BULLS IN VIRGINIA WERE MOSTLY STEADY TO \$3.00 LOWER AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE STEADY TO \$1.00 LOWER. BEEF PRO-**DUCTION WAS 4% BELOW A WEEK** AGO AND 6% BELOW A YEAR AGO. AVERAGE DRESSED WEIGHTS WERE 1 POUND HEAVIER THAN A YEAR AGO.

VEAL AND CALF PRICES IN VIRGI-NIA WERE NOT FULLY TESTED AS MIDWEST PRICES WERE \$1.00-5.00 LOWER. CALF AND VEAL PRODUC-TION WAS 3% ABOVE A WEEK AGO BUT 11% BELOW A YEAR AGO.
